Finance Director Huss stated representatives from Fogerty Arena propose to construct and equip a 28,000 square-foot indoor curling facility adjacent to the existing arena. He stated the proposal includes a request for the City to provide assistance with the issuance of a revenue note or other obligation in

an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000. He stated in addition to the curling facility, proceeds will be used to finance improvements to the existing indoor ice facility and to refinance outstanding debt. He stated the City would issue Conduit Debt bonds and the note or obligation will not constitute a charge, lien or encumbrance upon any property of the City except the project and will not be a charge against the City's general credit or taxing powers. He stated the project will be owned and operated by Fogerty Arena and will be payable by Fogerty pursuant to a revenue agreement.

Mayor Ryan opened the public hearing at 7:36 p.m.

Mark Clasen, Fogerty Arena, stated the footings are in and 80% of the panels are up and it is hoped to be finished and open on December 1, 2012.

Mayor Ryan asked about the height of the building. Mr. Clasen replied the height is about 18 feet.

Mr. Clasen commented that the Curling Association may want future office space at the facility.

City Manager Arneson stated the Council will discuss the ground lease at a future Workshop.

Councilmember Swanson inquired if the City saved on the interest rate. Finance Director Huss replied that is impossible to determine due to the market.

There being no public input, Mayor Ryan closed the public hearing at 7:44 p.m.

Moved by Councilmember Swanson, seconded by Councilmember Bourke, that this Resolution be Adopted. The Motion was adopted unanimously.
