**SUBJECT:** Community Center Task Force Applicants

Attached is a list of applicants who have expressed interest in serving on the Community Center Task Force. We received a total of 34 applicants from the community and community organizations. The list is broken down into several categories, those representing business, civic, and athletic organizations and then residents who are not representing a specific organization.

One suggestion for the make-up of the task force is as follows:

2 representatives from the Chamber of Commerce

1 representative from each civic organization (those with more than one can choose who is the representative and who is the alternate)

1 representative from each athletic association with 2 representatives from the BLSPAA as they represent several different sports (again those organizations with more than one listed applicant can choose who the representative is and who is the alternate)

1 representative from each of the school districts

2 representatives from the Park Board

All residents who expressed interest (11)

2 representatives from the City Council

This would add up to a task force of 29 members
