Project Management

For the sum of \$19,900, Great River Greening ecological staff will oversee and coordinate the 3 year establishment process for Blaine Wetland Sanctuary - South unit, to help ensure the success of the ongoing restoration project. Rare plant monitoring by others.

This will include oversight of the necessary labor forces to achieve mutual ecological habitat goals, including paid contractors; correctional facility crews; volunteers (recruitment by others); GRG hand crews; city staff as permitted/agreed upon. Neighbor relations by City.

GRG, in coordination with City staff, will pursue additional state and other funding for project enhancements, e.g. oak planting in the remaining tree groves.

Volunteer Engagement

Great River Greening's expert volunteer outreach team will recruit, coordinate, and engage volunteers for appropriate tasks throughout the Blaine Open Spaces, such as seed collection, seed sowing, aspen girdling, tree planting, and hand invasive species control. This will include two (2) medium sized volunteer events of 15-30 volunteers over the next 3 years, and 4 small volunteer events of 5-15 volunteers each over the next 3 years, for a total of 90 volunteer contacts. Greening will reach these volunteers through public recruitment using our vast database of volunteers, current relationships with Aveda and college professor, and/or connecting our interested private groups with the site, and/or a general public outreach on our part.
