CUP To Operate In City Of Blaine As A Farm Winery

I have included a copy of the MN law requiring a CUP to operate any winery in the State of MN. This is a requirement of the MN AGE (Alcohol Enforcement) for any wine production in MN. As I intend to purchase supplies from MN growers, this would fall under the Farm Winery rules. Mr. Schafer has received an approval letter (email) from the Association President, Tom Budzynski.

This is intended as a small, invisible, hobby winery. (No signage, traffic, on-site sales, etc.) We make a couple dozen cases of various varietals and sell them to friends, family, and the (soon) occasional small liquor store. We will also make custom labels for weddings, etc.

I do appreciate your time. I also apologize for the hassle, but my hands are tied by state rules. I ask for your approval of a CUP to operate as a Farm Winery out of my home at 4432 St. Andrews Drive.
