## APPROVE PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF 113TH AVENUE FROM PRESIDENT DRIVE TO JEFFERSON STREET

Installation of regulatory signs requires authorization by the City Council. A resident on the north side of 113<sup>th</sup> Avenue requested parking restrictions on the south side of 113<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Presidents Drive to Jefferson Street during school hours. The two property owners on the south side of 113<sup>th</sup> Avenue also contacted the City that they agree with parking restrictions during school hours. The Engineering Department and Police Department concur with this request.

By motion, approve the resolution.

**WHEREAS**, the Blaine City Council is cognizant of providing regulation of vehicular traffic in a safe and responsible manner; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance requires a City Resolution specifying the placement of regulatory signs; and

**WHEREAS**, the regulatory signs are considered to meet warrants for traffic control established in the Minnesota Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the City Council of the City of Blaine as follows:

1. Parking restrictions are hereby authorized to be installed on the South Side of 113th Avenue from President Drive to Jefferson Street, Monday through Friday during school hours of 8 to 10 AM and 3 to 5 PM.
