In accordance with the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, the City of Blaine hereby informs you that some or all of the information you are asked to provide is classified as private. Private data is available to you and to City staff who require it in the performance of their duties, but not to the public. The remainder of the information, including telephone numbers, is classified as public, and is available to the public. This information will be used to process your permit or license application. You may choose to withhold this information, however if you do, the City of Blaine may not be able to process your application for the permit or license.


