Scholarship Eligibility

The MAJESTIC OAKS/DKM (MO/DKM) Community Foundation was established with the purpose of assisting the Majestic Oaks community by providing funds that will benefit all members young and old with continuing education and academics, professional growth, health care assistance and for the overall good of the Majestic Oaks community. As part of this objective, the foundation will be granting a series of scholarships to eligible students.

Scholarship eligibility from the MO/DKM Foundation must meet the following criteria:


- 1) Applicant must be an employee of the Majestic Oaks Golf Club or be a direct relative, child or grandchild, of an individual within the Majestic Oaks Golf Club Community (MOGCC).

The MOGCC is defined as a broad based community that includes townhome owners and single-family homeowners located the subdivisions adjacent to Majestic Oaks Golf Club or a member of one of the many golf organizations at MO. These golf organizations may include numerous men's and women's golf leagues, various high school events or tournaments and similar related activities. This definition obviously serves many throughout the northern Twin Cities area.

- 2) Applicant must be accepted to an accredited institution of higher education, i.e. university, state college, technical college, vocational school, etc. The Board shall make the final determination to any institutional credentials.
- 3) Applicant must be a high school graduate or undergrad at a higher learning institution with a 2.5 GPA or better and be a full time student. (Submit transcripts with this application)
- 4) The application must be completed and submitted to the Scholarship Committee for review. The scholarship Committee will submit their recommendations to the Board of Directors for final consideration.
- 5) The Board shall make the final determination on an applicant's eligibility.
- 6) To be considered, the application must be received by March 1 of each year. Notification of the Board's decision will be made by May 1.
- 7) Successful applicants will be awarded their scholarship after they have notified the Board of their final decision on which institution they will be attending. The Foundation will issue a check to the institution in the name of the recipient after the start of the fall term. A letter of confirmation from the Foundation will be mailed to the recipient stating that the payment has been made.

The Board shall retain the right to make the final decision on all matters relative to Scholarship procedures.


