Staff Report

Summary of Eliminating and Redistributing Aquatore Park Ball Field #1 Use

The Park and Recreation Department assembled data on field usage of Aquatore Park Field #1 (AQ1) for the purpose of determining what the impact of removing the field would have on organized youth and adult athletics games conducted by the City of Blaine and its youth athletic groups. INTRODUCTION

Since 2004, the City of Blaine has maintained seven (7) lighted multi-use fields that are used for adult softball and football, youth baseball, soccer and football, girls' fast-pitch softball, and special events. The seasonal use is from April to October on weekday evenings and weekends. The impetus of this report is from the proposed construction of a National Curling Center that will attach to the south side of Fogerty Arena and the foot print of this expansion would necessitate the complete removal (AQ1). In an effort to determine the impact of eliminating this facility, staff obtained current (2011) facility use data of the seven multi-use fields and then redistributed this use to the six remaining multi-use fields. The 2011 data reflects a slightly higher than average level of usage from the past 7 years and is a good indicator of future use. The usage data focuses on the weekday evenings, Monday through Thursday, as it reflects the highest rate of use. Not to diminish weekends, but after reviewing the usage for April through October weekends, staff determined usage could be maintained with minimal adjustments.

CURRENT USE OF AQUATORE AND AIRPORT PARK FIELDS

The table below depicts the percent of usage for the City's current seven lighted multi-use fields. The summary for weekday use is from data of Monday through Thursday, 6:00-10:00 p.m.

REDISTRIBUTING USE OF AQUATORE PARK FIELD #1

With the proposal of eliminating AQ1 and at the same time maintain the City's existing level of facility use for youth and adult athletics, staff has redistributed AQ1 use to the six other multiuse facilities. The following table illustrates the effects of redistributing weekday use.

CONCLUSION

Staff concludes that if AQ1 is eliminated, usage can be maintained with modifications to facility scheduling, leagues and demands. However, the following conditions resulting from redistributing of AQ1 usage should be considered.

- Field use will be at, near or over capacity for the months of May, June and July.
- Overall usage will need to be reduced by approximately 6% in June either through scheduling 10:00 p.m. games at Aquatore and Airport Park fields or limiting the number of adult softball teams or both. It should be noted that revenue generated from adult programs subsidizes youth recreation activities and any reduction of adult teams will decrease this support.
- Conducting weekend softball/baseball/football tournaments at Aquatore Park will be limited to two fields, if Airport Park is not available.
- AQ2 and AQ3 will be isolated or disjointed from the scheme of the entire park site.
- Aquatore Park may not be as an attractive venue for special events such as the annual car and Blaine Blazin' Festival show as it could limit set-up and operations.
- Youth football will have one less lighted field possibly resulting in more away games for Blaine/SLP AA teams.

The conclusion and usage data presented in this report is based on not replacing AQ1. If the National Curling Center moves forward, staff would recommend acquisition of a similar facility or site to accommodate future growth of youth and adult athletic programs in the City of Blaine.
