We are asking that you consider placing a parking restriction on Dunkirk Street NE and 122nd Court NE. We are concerned about the safety of the street when there are people parking to walk to the beach. There are instances when there have been vehicles parked on both sides of the street making it impossible to have 2 cars pass normally and the postal service has had difficulty delivering mail due to the number of cars parked on the street. We are also concerned about the safety of pedestrians, especially the children who are frequently walking on our street-the amount of cars parked on the street makes visibility of pedestrians, especially young children difficult. Please also take into consideration the curvature of Dunkirk Street NE and how 122nd Court NE joins Dunkirk St NE. The increased number of vehicles parked on Dunkirk Street NE in addition to the design of the road seems to further increase the safety risk.

We would like you to consider a parking restriction on both sides of Dunkirk Street NE and 122nd Court NE from June 1st to Labor Day between the hours of 10am and 8pm, or simply no beach parking.
