The applicant is requesting a Conditional Use Permit to allow for more than two accessory structures on the lot which is zoned R-1 (Single Family). The applicant currently has three accessory structures in the rear yard of the lot that total 980 square feet in size. The conditional use permit would bring the lot into conformance with zoning ordinance requirements by allowing the three structures (detached garage and two sheds) to remain in place.
