**Subject:** Traffic in The Lakes

I am a resident of Blaine who lives in the Lakes of Radisson. Over the last few months I have noticed an increase in the traffic in our development especially on Lakes Parkway. I am not sure if the increase is due to the roadwork on Main Street or if it is from the new development north of Main Street. I feel like people are cutting through the Lakes of Radisson to avoid the lights on West Lake and Main, on Radisson and Main, and on Radisson and Lakes Parkway. Cutting through the neighborhood reduces it to one light instead of 3. I am an avid walker and I have noticed almost a constant stream of cars on Lakes Parkway from Harpers to Radisson. Many cars are speeding and they do not slow down at the crosswalks. I have seen 4 near accidents in the past month. Last evening I saw a truck speed down Lakes Parkway and almost hit a teenager walking his dog. The truck never slowed down. This is an active community with many walkers, joggers, and children. Something needs to be done to prevent a tragic accident. I feel that an all way stop sign should be added at the intersection of West Lake and Lakes Parkway. A stop sign should be added on Lakes Parkway at the beach as cars come speeding over the bridge. An all way stop sign should be added at the intersection of North/South Lake and Lakes Parkway. And it would be a good idea to add an all way stop at the western intersection of Aspen Lake Drive and South Lake as cars come barreling down South Lake where people are making left turns to cut through to 116th. Multiple stop signs were added on 119th after a man was killed by a speeding car. I feel that something should be done in the Lakes before someone gets killed. The stop signs on 119th have been helpful in diverting traffic out of that area. I think it would be helpful in the Lakes. Dawn Yetter

**Subject:** Suggestion for a 4 way stop

Hello Blaine Police Dept.,

I'm a resident of The Lakes neighborhood for last 8 years. I want to make a suggestion for your consideration here.

There is a two way stop in the intersection of N Lake Dr and the Lakes Pkwy (Near East Lake Park) where the traffic on the Lakes Pkwy doesn't need to stop but the traffic on the N Lake Blvd has to stop. The trees became so dense if you are travelling towards west (towards 125th) you won't be able to see the traffic from other side. Pedestrian traffic has increased over years specially to go either to the East Lake Park or Sunrise Lake trail. We (me and mywife) personally take this route everyday to go to the Sunrise Lake with our kids

There my suggestion is to convert it to a 4 way stop. Appreciate if you can do a survey on this and take necessary action.
