4.1 Motion 16-071, Request Incentive Payment for Branch 3 Wetland Banking Project.

Moved by Commissioner Swanson, seconded by Commissioner Hovland, that "Motion 16-071, "Request Incentive Payment for Branch 3 Wetland Banking Project," be approved.

Stormwater Manager Hafner stated the approved contract amount for the project was not to exceed \$454,912.50. He stated the original RFP for the project included a per acre incentive for each acre of wetland credit over the 40-acre minimum which added to the project cost. The project is complete and 55 acres of credit have been created. He noted the credits have been deposited in the State wetland bank. The project came in under budget at \$425,514. The incentive payment is \$30,000.
