



Come and explore the Blaine Wetland Sanctuary.
This 500 acre dedicated open space is now accessible for the public to escape the urban landscape and reconnect with nature.

An extensive boardwalk meanders through the wetland, allowing you to experience a serene and natural environment. The boardwalk extends from the trailhead on Lexington Avenue through both wetland and upland habitats connecting to East Lake Park.

Future plans for the BWS include additional trails (exact locations are yet to be determined) and a nature center at the Lexington Avenue trailhead.

Management of the wetland site will continue into the future to accomplish the plan approved by the regulatory agencies.

During spring and summer, crews will be out applying herbicides to control the invasive species which inhibit the growth of the native vegetation.

Prescribed burns and over-seeding with native herbaceous species will allow the area to thrive and provide important habitat for birds and wildlife.

The health of a wetland takes maintenance and care. The City of Blaine is committed to preserve this area for the enjoyment of the community and the future of our environment.
