The residents of Hidden Acres, located on Pierce St. NE between 113th and 114th Ave. NE, request that the City of Blaine Parks and Recreation place two pickle ball courts in Hidden Ponds Park. Hidden Ponds park is located on Polk St NE and 114th Ave.

Hidden Acres is a community of 29 one level homes. The majority of residents are older and active adults. Several are actively playing Pickle Ball. Two new developments will be built near by, primarily for the older and mostly retired adults. One, to be built just east of Pierce street (Meadow Place), will have 40 homes.
