



# Overnight Parking Ordinance

# INTRODUCTION

Current ordinances – misdemeanors \$50 fine

From November 1 to April 1, no person shall park or permit to be parked any vehicle on any highway, street, or alley between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. without an emergency parking permit issued by the city police department. Any vehicle parked in violation of this section may be removed as provided by section 82-61.

It shall be unlawful to park or permit to be parked, or to continue to park or permit to stand, any vehicle upon any street after two inches or more of snowfall, until such time as the snow has been plowed from the street, curb to curb.



# Options

- ▶ Keep ordinance as is – Coon Rapids, Spring Lake Park, Ham Lake, Lino Lakes, Brooklyn Park, Woodbury, Golden Valley, Vadnais Heights, Edina
- ▶ No parking overnight year round – Champlin, Maple Grove, Maplewood, Apple Valley, Arden Hills, Mounds View, New Brighton
- ▶ Eliminate overnight parking ordinance – Minneapolis, St. Paul, Robbinsdale, New Hope, Richfield



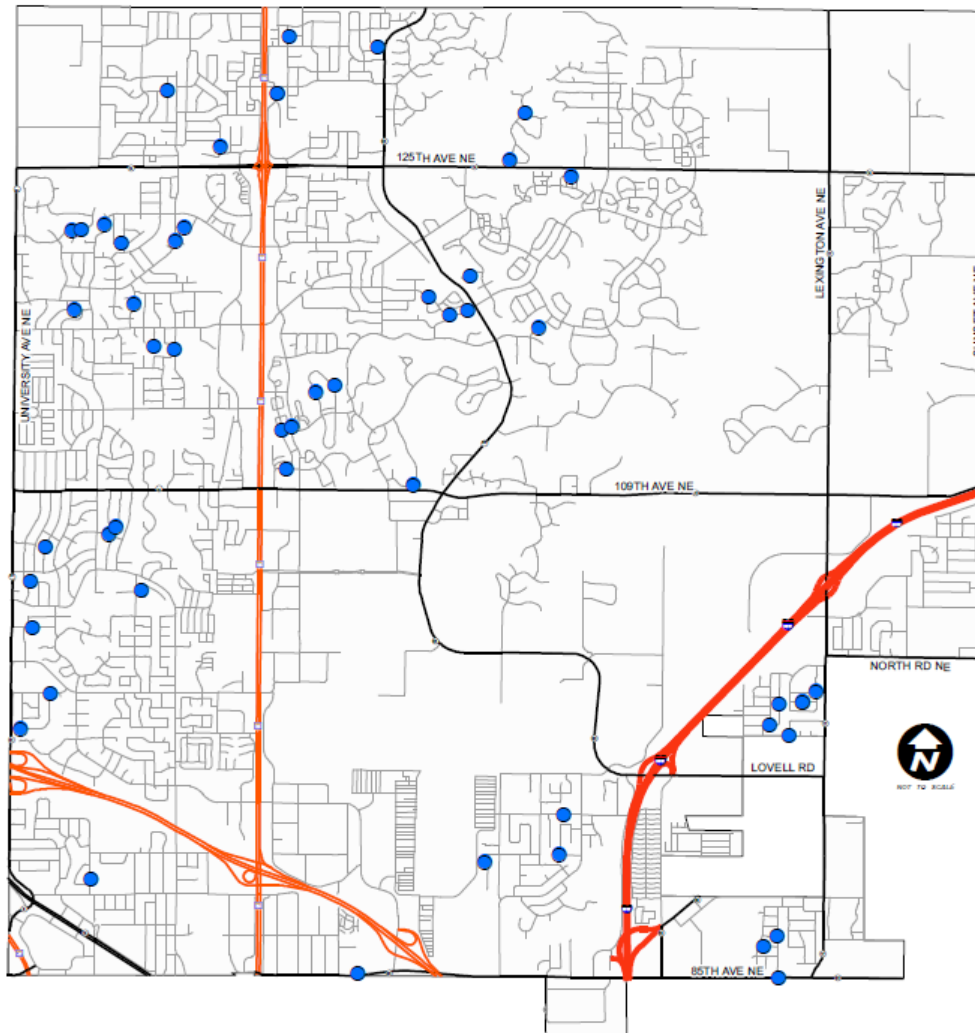
# Stats
