## 2021 Capital Budget

#### Beginning stages of review

- >Need-based
  - Aligned with mission
  - Aligned with Strategic Plan
- Condition of equipment

#### Buildings, Improvements

- Public Works
  - Gas station canopy \$180,000
  - Salt shed canopy \$45,000
  - South parking lot \$212,000
  - Police lot/sally port \$59,200
  - ➢ Fire parking lot − \$32,000
  - >Additional parking security lighting \$25,000

#### Vehicles

Reviewing replacement schedule

- Rotation/re-purposing to other departments or divisions
- Looking at lease options

Consider conducting a comprehensive study

#### Vehicles – Safety Services

- Police typically 6-10 vehicles/year
  - >1 Admin vehicle
  - 8 patrol vehicles (2 patrol sedans placed on hold in 2020 added to 2021 requests)
  - >2 Special operations vehicle
  - ►1 CSO vehicle
- >1 Community Standards (2020 carry-over)

#### Vehicles – Public Works

- Parks Maintenance 1 Supervisor (replaces 2007 F-250)
- Engineering 2 Techs (replaces 2008 F-150; 2009 F-150)
- Vehicles Community Development
  2 Inspector vehicles (2020 carry-over)

#### Heavy Machinery – Public Works

Streets Maintenance –

Replace – 2 Bobcats; Wheel loader w/ box plow;

New – Crash attenuator; Rotary broom (for clearing snow off trails)

Carry-over – Tilt-bed trailer; Ventrax trailer

#### Heavy Machinery – Public Works

Parks Maintenance –

**Replace – 2 Toro 72" mowers; John Deere tractor** 

New – 2 Garbage tipper inserts; GPS field striper; Tow-behind mower deck

Carry-over – Ballfield groomer

#### Computers/Technology

- >\$330,050 total requested
  - >\$44,020 replacement
  - \$96,500 carry-over (mostly planning and inspections programs, software)
  - >\$189,500 New Programs
    - >\$175,000 Disaster recovery project
    - Building Inspection iPads; roadside fingerprint scanner; Vehicle maintenance computer

- **Other Equipment \$328,650** 
  - >\$166,150 replaced equipment
  - >\$16,000 Carry-over
  - >\$146,500 New programs
    - Safety Services Unmanned aerial vehicle; First responder fire suppressor; Less-than-lethal munitions; warning siren
    - Public works Ice machine; Commercial washer/dryer

#### **SBM**

Suspended all planned capital purchases for 2021, except \$36,500 in PPE
