City Hall Improvements Current City Hall

- ► Opened in 2002
 - ▶ 114,640 square feet that includes unfinished third floor.



City Hall Improvements



- Since 2002 the city has added 33 staff and has seen increased demand for community space.
- Council actions
 - ➤ 2017 Conducted space needs study for city hall/police department.
 - ➤ 2019 –Wold Architects and RJM Construction Management hired to design city hall/police department improvements.
 - ➤ 2019- Developed budget of \$4.2 million for improvements.

City Hall Improvements

- Design includes creation of customer service center that will be able to handle most resident inquiries and serve as a welcoming spot. This space will have protective glass barriers.
- ► Additional detailed information including project history available in agenda packet.



City Hall Improvements Financing of Improvements

- ► August 2019 Council authorized the sale of \$4.2 million in Capital Improvement Bonds to finance city hall/police department improvements.
 - ▶ Bond proceeds can only be used for city hall/police department improvements.
 - ▶ Bond proceeds must be spent within three years.
 - ▶ If not spent the bonds become taxable for the bond holders, reducing their yield.
 - ➤ The city's credit rating will be affected for sale of future bonds.



City Hall Improvements Estimated Timeline



- Prepare final design and bid documents December, 2020
- ► Issue bids January, 2021
- Council approval of bids February, 2021
- Construction done in phases February to July, 2021
