ACCEPT BID FROM DUNAWAY CONSTRUCTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$124,947.50 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF HARPERS PARK, IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NO. 15-06

Bids were received at 10:00 a.m., July 21, 2015, for Project No. 15-06. A total of three bids were received ranging from \$124,947.50 to \$232,938.50. The Engineer’s estimate for construction and three lowest bidders are as follows:

Engineer’s Estimate - Construction Cost	\$130,000.00
Dunaway Construction	\$124,947.50
Ebert Construction, Inc.	\$143,903.33
Barber Construction, Inc.	\$232,938.50

Bids have been checked and tabulated, and it has been determined that Dunaway Construction of Columbus, MN, is the lowest bidder. The Engineering Department has worked with Dunaway Construction on previous projects. I recommend the low bid be accepted and a contract entered into with Dunaway Construction.

City Council is also asked to approve a 10% contingency to bring the total project budget to \$137,442.25. The funding source for this project is the Park Fund and there are sufficient funds to cover these costs.

By motion, adopt the resolution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement for bids for Improvement Project No. 15-06, said bids were received on July 21, 2015, opened and tabulated according to law, and the following three lowest bids were received complying with the advertisement:

Dunaway Construction	\$124,947.50
Ebert Construction, Inc.	\$143,903.33
Barber Construction, Inc.	\$232,938.50

AND WHEREAS, Dunaway Construction of Columbus, Minnesota, is the lowest

responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Blaine as follows:

1. The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Dunaway Construction for the designated improvements in the amount of \$124,947.50.
2. A 10% contingency is hereby approved to bring the total project budget to \$137,442.25 and the Public Services Manager is hereby authorized to sign all change orders up to the authorized project budget amount.
3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to return forthwith to all bidders the bid bonds submitted with their bids, except the three lowest bidders. When a contract is duly executed, the bid bonds of the two remaining unsuccessful bidders will be returned. The bid bond of the successful bidder will be retained until the performance and payment bonds have been executed and approved, after which the bid bond will be returned.
