JOINT MEETING WITH THE NATURAL RESOURCE CONSERVATION BOARD

The Natural Resource Conservation Board would like to conduct a joint meeting with the Park Board. A suggested list of topics developed by the NRCB are:

Topics:

1. Signage at parks and open spaces:
 - a. Improved sign on Lexington Ave. for Lochness Park
 - b. Interpretive sign for Laddie Lake improvements
2. Kiosks
3. Adopt-a-Park, Trail, etc.
4. Special events in parks/open spaces (kite flying on the ice, festival at The Lakes, etc.)
5. Earth Day event
6. Trail maintenance
7. Shoreline maintenance
8. Encroachment onto City lands
 - a. illegal dumping
 - b. yard waste dumping
9. Transplant Trillium plants at Laddie Lake
10. Develop environmental policy for Blaine
 - a. Existing parks and trails.
 - b. Future parks.
 - c. Future open space.
 - d. Management of parks and open space.

The joint meeting could take place at a workshop or regular meeting setting. If the workshop session is chosen, staff is recommending Tuesday, March 13, 6:30 p.m. The regular meeting is Tuesday, March 27. If Park Board

members also have topics they would want covered at the joint meeting they can e-mail them to staff by March 9 in order to include them on the joint meeting agenda.
