### **GRANTING APPROVAL TO CONDUCT OFF-SITE GAMBLING AT THE TPC TWIN CITIES ON APRIL 24, 2017 FOR THE SPRING LAKE PARK LIONS**

The Spring Lake Park Lions have submitted an application to conduct off-site charitable gambling on April 24, 2017 at the TPC for a bingo and paddlewheel event with proceeds going back to the community. The Spring Lake Park Lions organization currently has a premises permit for The Roadside, Gabe's, and Banquets of Minnesota.

The Gambling Control Board will not issue an off-site permit for charitable gambling within a city unless the sponsoring organization obtains city approval through Council resolution; therefore, this resolution is being presented to the Council for approval.

By motion approve the Resolution.

**WHEREAS**, the Spring Lake Park Lions, 8433 Center Drive, Spring Lake Park has applied for an off-site gambling permit at the TPC Twin Cities to be held on April 24, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes 349.213, Subd. 2, states that the Gambling Control Board may not issue an off-site gambling permit within the City of Blaine unless the City Council approves the off-site permit within sixty (60) days of the date of application.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Blaine as follows:

The application for the off-site gambling permit for the purpose of conducting charitable gambling is hereby approved.

A certified copy of this resolution shall be provided to the applicant as soon as possible for submittal to the Gambling Control Board.
