### **VACATION OF DRAINAGE AND UTILITY EASEMENT AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF RADISSON ROAD AND 105<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE (10500 RADISSON ROAD), VACATION NO. V17-04**

Public and written notice has been provided as required by City Charter. A petition dated August 11, 2017, was submitted to the City by Mark J. Manderfeld, A&G Business Services, LLC, representing Joyce B. Gabrelcik requesting vacation of drainage and utility easement. The property has been sold to Kwik Trip, Inc. who wishes to redevelop it and has applied to rezone the property and plat it with new drainage and utility easements. The applicants represent 100% of the affected property abutting this easement. The Engineering Department has reviewed this request and concurs with the vacation.
