WHEREAS, the plan consists of six strategic priorities-the issues of greatest importance to the city over the next three years-effective communication, financial stability, growth management, organizational health, TH 65 improvement, and well-maintained infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, associated with each strategic priority is a set of desired outcomes, key outcome indicators, and performance targets that describe expected results and how results will be measured; and

WHEREAS, the plan's resulting mission statement is to deliver exceptional public services with the highest degree of professionalism and accountability; and

WHEREAS, the city's mission will be accomplished through core values of transparency and openness; fairness and impartiality; creativity and innovation, respect and efficiency; and

WHEREAS, during the implementation of the plan a vision statement for the city will be developed. This vision statement will be designed to look towards the future aspirations of the City of Blaine.
